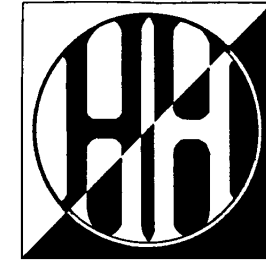

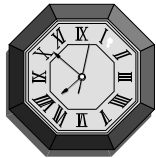

Attendance Facts

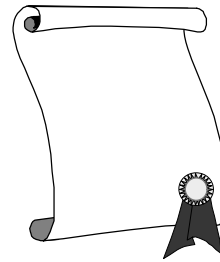
- ❖ A School Year has 190 teaching days.
- ❖ Two weeks holiday taken within in the school term means 10 days of schooling lost
equivalent to over 5% of the school year
equivalent to 60 lessons.

- ❖ Lateness to school of 15 minutes a day is:-



- equivalent** to 1 hour 15 minutes a week
equivalent to 47 ½ hours a year
equivalent to 57 lessons
- ❖ Absences not reported by Parents or Carers must be recorded as unauthorised and so regarded as truancy
- ❖ You may be contacted by our Attendance Clerk if your child is not in school

Achievement Facts



- ❖ The students who achieve the highest grades or levels, have an attendance of 95% or above
- ❖ The students who have attendance of 90% and above, nearly always achieve their target grade or level
- ❖ Two thirds of all students who have an attendance of 89%, struggle to achieve their target grade or level
- ❖ Students who have an attendance of less than 80% fail to achieve their target grade or level

What you can do to help your child succeed

- ❖ Wherever possible ensure holidays are taken in school holiday periods.
- ❖ Permission must be requested in writing from Mr French, for any holidays to be taken in term time.
- ❖ If holidays have to be taken in term time, (or if your child is absent for any reason) ensure that your child copies up any missed work quickly, upon their return (the responsibility falls with your child and is a condition of any holidays being authorised in term time). Remember, revision for exams cannot be undertaken if they do not have details of work covered in their absence.
- ❖ Ensure your child leaves home early enough, to arrive at school on time.
- ❖ Discuss the impact of lost time on your child's chances of success
- ❖ Make sure you contact the school to inform us of any absences as soon as possible
